







#### **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

ALL JUNIORS AND SENIORS WITH AN UNROUNDED, WEIGHTED GPA OF 90.0

OR HIGHER ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY TO

WTHS NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY.



#### SELECTION REQUIREMENTS

# Candidate Application Essay Rubrics

- Used to objectively score student essays on character and leadership
- Posted on <u>WTHS NHS website</u>









- The faculty council shall consist of five (5) voting faculty members appointed annually by the principal or designee.
- The chapter adviser shall be an ex officio, non-voting, sixth member of the faculty council.
- No principal or assistant principal may be included on the faculty council as a voting member.



#### TAKE AWAYS

- Review the application in Naviance soon.
- Review the essay rubrics on the WTHS NHS webpage.
- Use Word or Google Docs to compose essays
   & save your work.
- List all community service and activities from grade 9 to present.
- Utilize the last page for any special circumstances (transferred to WTHS, disability, injury, hardship, etc)
- Ask someone to review your final application before you submit.
- Don't wait until last minute to submit.
- Be certain you submitted. Application can only be submitted one time.
