The assignment is posted on the materials page of the AP World History Summer 2024 course in Schoology. Students who registered for the AP World History course in the spring of 2024 have already been added to the Schoology course. Students may submit completed sections of the assignment electronically through Schoology OR download, print, and submit hardcopies in class on Wednesday, September 4. The assignment will be graded as a supportive assessment. A minor assessment will be given in class mid-late September based on this material.

I fully understand how anxious many of you are beginning your high school career and taking your very first Advanced Placement course. While the work will be challenging, it is not impossible. For the past four years, every student that signed up for the course not only survived, but many scored well above the national average on the AP examination.
