### Dear Parents/Guardians:

This year's Senior Prom will be held on Thursday, May 22, 2025, 6:30PM to 10:30PM at the Sheraton Hotel, in Atlantic City. Since we would like to eliminate any possible problems at this formal dance, we require every person who plans to attend the prom to have their parents/guardians read and sign this list of prom rules and regulations. Any student not returning this paper, signed by parents or guardians, may not purchase a prom ticket.

# Please be informed about the following rules and regulations:

- 1. Students with 5 or more suspensions will <u>not</u> be allowed to attend the prom. WTPS Regulation 5850.1
- 2. Any student who is in **NON-CREDIT STATUS** will not be permitted to attend the prom.
- 3. Students may bring ONE (1) guest if they choose. The guest may be in another grade or school. All students and guests MUST arrive together and be assigned to the same table. Students are not permitted to bring multiple guests to the WTHS Junior Prom.
- 4. Smoking/vaping is NOT permitted at any time during the prom.
- 5. No one will be admitted to the prom one hour after it begins. This year's prom begins at <u>6:30PM</u>. Attendees will not be admitted <u>after 7:30PM</u>.
- 6. Any attendee who is found to be under the influence of alcohol or a CDS (controlled dangerous substance) and/or in the possession of the above will have their parents contacted and will be sent home from the dance. In addition, the student will be suspended, pursuant to WT Board of Education policy regarding substance abuse and/or possession and subject to all the sanctions contained within. Passive Alcohol Sensors or PAS (referred to as Breathalyzers) will be utilized. All attendees entering the dance will be required to speak into the PAS. Any attendee refusing to be screened will not be admitted to the dance. In addition, the Passive Alcohol Sensors will be used throughout the evening if the need arises.
- 7. There will be <u>NO</u> refunds for tickets and/or other costs if students: arrive late or are sent home from school for disciplinary reasons on the day of the prom and are told not to attend that evening. <u>No refunds will be given after May 10<sup>th</sup>.</u>
- Students are to remain at the prom until 10:00 PM.
- 9. Any changes of guest or table assignments must be approved by Mrs. Mroz by May 9th. Therefore, any student or guest not included on the final list of guests will not be permitted into the prom.
- Each <u>student</u> attending the Prom must attend school the day of the prom. Since May 22<sup>nd</sup> is a ½ day of school, any student arriving to school after 8:00 am, <u>WILL NOT</u> be permitted to attend the prom.
- 11. <u>Appropriate formal attire is required</u>. Inappropriate behavior of any kind <u>WILL NOT</u> be permitted. All attendees will follow the WTPS Student Code of Conduct.
- 12. It is the attendee's responsibility to care for their own personal belongings. **DO NOT** leave valuables unattended. WTHS and the Sheraton Hotel are not responsible for lost or stolen items. **Backpacks and large bags are prohibited**. Small purses are permitted but are subject to being searched.
