# Common Interview Questions (College)

- Why come to this school?
- Did you get what you wanted out of high school?
- How did you contribute to your high school?
- What do you do in leisure time?
- What do you like to read?
- What are your plans after postsecondary school?
- How will our school help you with these plans?
- Are your grades and test scores an accurate indication of your abilities?
- How would you describe yourself?
- How would people describe you?
- What do you do in the summer?
- What is your family like?

## Common Post-Interview Questions (College)

### Hot Tip: ALWAYS ask questions after an interview!

- What is special about your school?
- How is your school different from any other school?
- Which departments are strong and why?
- Do you graduates find jobs? Do you help them find jobs? With whom do they find jobs?
- If I am undecided concerning my major, what help will I be able to get?
- What matters socially to your students?
- How current is your technology?
- If my academic record is acceptable to your school, what personal qualities are you looking for?
- What are your research opportunities?
- How would you evaluate my school report?
- Would I be acceptable?
- Should I apply?

# Common Interview Questions (Employment)

- What are your weaknesses?
- Describe yourself in three words?
- What has been your greatest achievement?
- What are your strengths?
- Describe a time when you have failed?
- Why should we choose you for this role?
- Why did you apply for this job?
- How will you contribute to the team?
- Describe a situation where you have gone above and beyond?
- Describe a project you have handled?
- What attracted you to this company?
- How would your friends describe you?
- Describe a situation where you have had others follow your lead?
- Name a time where you have worked under pressure?
- What attributes do you have that will support you in this role?

# Common Post-Interview Questions (Employment)

### Hot Tip: ALWAYS ask questions after an interview!

- What's the next step in the interview/hiring process?
- How long does your recruitment process usually take?
- What are the primary responsibilities of the position?
- What would my day-to-day routine look like if I got the job?
- What can you tell me about the job apart from what was in the description?
- What would I be expected to accomplish in my first month/year on the job?
- What is the key to succeeding in this role?
- What does it look like during the busiest and toughest times for this role?
- Would I need to travel for the position?
- What kind of hours are expected for me to perform the role at maximum capacity?
- Is overtime expected and/or allowed?
- Could you tell me a little bit about the person I would report to directly?
- What is the onboarding process like for new hires?
- How many people will I be working with?
- If I were hired for the position, what would be the ideal starting date?
- Do you expect the responsibilities for this role to change in the near future?
