Over the last week we have been inundated with an excessive amount of vandalism in the school restrooms. Despite our best efforts for having students sign into the restrooms and inspecting the restrooms before and after uses, we are finding that some students are still engaging in mischievous behavior. This stems from a recent Tik Tok craze called "Devious Licks" which has gained traction across the country. The gist of this trend encourages kids/Tik Tok users to do an act of vandalism or theft to school property then post it on social media. This obviously has become highly disruptive for our building, our staff, and especially our students who we have to question as a result of an investigation. This has started to manifest itself in some students taking hand sanitizers and wipes from the teachers' desks and classrooms as well.


Students at first think this is funny, but what is happening is that students are obviously getting disciplined per the Code of Conduct for theft/vandalism and required to pay for the damage done or replacement of items.
