Dear Families of 8th Grade Bulldogs:

8th grade recognition is on **Friday, June 14 at 8:45 AM**. Please click on this [link](#) to familiarize yourself with all the particulars.

1. **Today, I gave all 8th graders 2 tickets. These tickets are only for admission into the gym in the event that it rains Friday morning. This is due to spacing constraints. If it rains, no one without a ticket will be permitted to view recognition.**
  - It looks like as if its over a 50% to rain in the afternoon. Again, I will keep you abreast of any changes. I will make a final call via Remind by 7:30 am on 6/14.
  - Each 8th grader signed for their two tickets. Please make sure you ask for them and get them. They were instructed to bring them home.
  - If your child was absent today, they will get the tickets tomorrow. 6/11
  
2. **If the recognition/graduation is outside, it will likely be sunny and hot. We ask the following:**
  - Students should have water, sunscreen, and sunglasses if they have them. No hats
  - Students should wear clothes representative of the dignified event but not so much that they become overheated.
  - Families should arrive before 8:45, begin parking and walk to the back of the school. Families will not walk into the school they will walk to the back.
  - Families should bring their own lawn chairs, water, or blanket to sit in the field behind the school
  - Families try to keep their guests to around four guests and carpool as much as possible. Our space for parking is very limited.
  
3. **WE REQUEST YOU NOT TAKE YOUR CHILD HOME AFTER THE EVENT**
  - Our class council and PTO and team leaders have worked incredibly hard to create an end of year event.
  - We will have social gatherings, food, music, class awards, and yearbook signing. There will not be an event of this magnitude on Monday.
  - There has been a lot of coordination and effort to make our students' graduation day special. We ask that all children stay to partake.
