On this day, during one or two class periods, we will be engaging in this trail. All middle schools in the district will be conducting the trial on this day as well. The PARCC testing will occur May 15, 16, & 17 at the middle level.

This as part of celebrating 20 years of musicals at BHMS, we are having donations only as the entry fee for the shows and inviting some alumni back to watch and be part of the festivities.
